#### **CONTRACTED WORK:**

##### Preparation:

- Move furniture to centers, all small items are removed by client
- Cover floors and room items appropriately
- Remove outlet and switch covers
- Tape off items as needed
- Fix cracks in walls

##### Dining Room

- Ceiling, apply 2 coats of 1/8 formula TWINE
- Walls, apply 2 coats of Carmel
- Artistic Moldings, apply 2 coats of TWINE
- Crown molding to be color of either ceiling or walls, ask customer

##### Living Room

- Ceiling, apply 2 coats of Behr 290C-1 Serengeti Sand
- Walls, apply 2 coats of Amber Wave
- Accent Cove, apply 2 coats Behr 290C-3

##### Stairwell up to 2<sup>nd</sup> floor

- Ceiling, apply 2 coats of 1/8 formula TWINE
- Walls, apply 2 coats of TWINE

Price of Labor: \$1040

Price of Paint & Materials: \$130 using all ProGreen 200 low VOC, add \$75 for upgrading to Duration flat, washable paint for the walls in the dining, living, and stairwell up.

**PAYMENT TERMS:**

Deposit:	25%	Due on signing
Final Payment:	75% plus all change orders, materials & paints.	End of Major Work Notice Provided* Payment due or postmarked within 5 workdays of the notice.

\* Colorwheel considers itself fully capable of completing any/all final items within 5 days after leaving its End of Major Work Notice. Failure of client to allow Colorwheel access to finish any final items does not void the clients requirement to pay on time. Failure of client to do a walk through/inspection of the work and arrange for Colorwheel to complete any needed final items, given adequate notice, within 5 days does not void the client’s requirement to pay on time. Failure to provide on-time final payment: \$10/day until paid

**COLOR SELECTION, CONSULTATION, AND SAMPLES**

Painting of color samples, consultation, and help with color selection will be tracked and billed on an additional hourly basis. This allows the customer to get as much consultation and as many samples as needed. This billing includes related drive time, store time, the actual paint costs (even if not used) and all related time put into the sample colors or consultation process. Once a color has been selected, it will be added to a “Color Selections Sheet” and be signed by client. The billing rate for these services is \$50/hr.

**NOTICE REGARDING CHANGES OR ADDITIONAL WORK**

This document represents the entire contract between the parties. Any changes must be in writing and signed by all parties. Colors must be chosen by the client prior to commencement of work unless otherwise noted. If, after the job stars, a color change is required, Colorwheel Painting, LLC will have to charge for time and material expenses incurred on the original color as well as all time and materials needed to complete the new scope of work to be done.

**NOTICE TO CLIENT:**

Signing proposal hereby enters you into a contract. Do not sign this contract if there are any blank spaces. You are entitled to a copy of this contract at the time you sign it. All penalties for an unpaid balance are indicated within this contract. Contractor is entitled to actual attorneys fees and collection costs. Owner to carry fire, tornado and other necessary insurance. (Builders risk). Any employees will be covered under Worker’s Compensation Insurance required by law. Liquidated damages for breach of contract by the buyer of the contract shall not exceed 10% of the contract price, nor in any event exceed more than \$100. As required by the Wisconsin construction lien law, builder hereby notifies owner that persons or companies furnishing labor or materials for the construction on owner’s land may have lien rights on owner’s land and buildings if not paid. Those entitled to lien rights, in addition to the undersigned builder, are those who contract directly with the owner or those who give the owner notice within 60 days after they first furnish labor or materials for the construction. Accordingly, owner probably will receive notices from those who furnish labor or materials for the construction, and should give a copy of each notice received to his mortgage lender, if any. Builder agrees to cooperate with the owner and his lender, if any, to see that all potential lien claimants are duly paid.
